Here's some information on things you may need to know during your stay at Cosy Lodge... Have a great holiday!

BEACH STUFF

Please feel free to use the buckets and spades, chairs, Windbreaker, beach toys, body boards and fishing nets in the storage area under the decking. Please do not rinse excessive sand into the shower or bath/sinks as this will block the drains.

We appreciate honesty so, if something is broken, please do replace on a like for like basis – thank you!


RECOMMENDED DAYS OUT / PLACES TO EAT

There is an A5 book on the kitchen shelf which has recommendations in the front and back from guests for nice places to visit and eateries to try.

Also please feel free to browse the leaflets on walks to do and places to go that are in the basket next to the fireplace.

TV / DVD PLAYER

The TV should hopefully be self explanatory.





CD PLAYER with FM radio and idock

Self explanatory - plays CDs, FM radio or music from your ipod/ iphone via the idock on the front of the player.

LAMPS

The lamp next to the TV is touch sensitive – you just press the base up to 3 times depending on how bright you want it.

HEATING

The heating is controlled by a thermostat on the wall in the hallway. Please adjust it to your desired temperature. Please could you ensure that the heating thermostat is turned down to the minimum setting when you leave.

ELECTRIC FIRE

The controls are on the bottom of the hood and are fairly self-explanatory. The on/off switch is on the left and the fire settings are on the right (there's an isolator switch on the wall to the right). You have three options: Just flames effect, flames effect and heat or just heat.

SEWING KIT

There is a mini sewing kit, if needed, in the kitchen drawer.



COOKER

To operate the hobs press and hold down the knob to release the gas as you press the ignition key. Hold it down **for a few seconds** before releasing.

To turn on the oven select your desired setting on the middle knob on the front of the cooker. Then select your temperature on the right-hand side and there's a timer on the left. Full instructions are in the kitchen drawer.

The fridge freezer is to the left of the kettle area. You will find power switches on the kitchen wall for the oven, hob ignition and the fridge freezer (please do not turn the boiler switch off).

WASHING MACHINE

There is a washing machine in the kitchen, which you are welcome to use, and there are tumble driers in the building directly opposite to Cosy Lodge. Washing machine instructions are in the kitchen drawers if needed.

FIRE EXTINGUISHER

If required, there is a fire extinguisher in the corner next to the draining board by the kitchen window.

BINS / RECYCLING

Rubbish and recycling can be put in the large bins in the fenced off, covered area across the road towards the play area. There should be some fresh bin liners under the sink in the kitchen. Please do ensure that there is a new bin liner in before using the bin.

BATHROOMS

Please use the squeegee in the Ensuite shower to wipe the walls and shower screens after use.

VACUUM CLEANER

If required, a vacuum cleaner is in the wardrobe of the bunk room.

IRON / IRONING BOARD

There is an ironing board and iron in the wardrobe of the bunk room.

HAIR DRYER / HOT WATER BOTTLE

A Hair Dryer can be found in the bedside cabinet of the Double room. You'll also find a hot water bottle if needed.

BLACK-OUT BLINDS

For our guests' convenience, there are black-out blinds available in the top drawer in each of the bedrooms. These are really easy to use and consist of pieces of blackout material which fits each window and fixes to the Velcro. (Please be gentle when removing them from the Velcro.)

E-VEHICLES

There is no charging point on-site, please do not charge from the plugs in the lodge. The nearest public charging points are around Padstow.
